**If you have a clothes rail we could borrow, please contact the school office.**

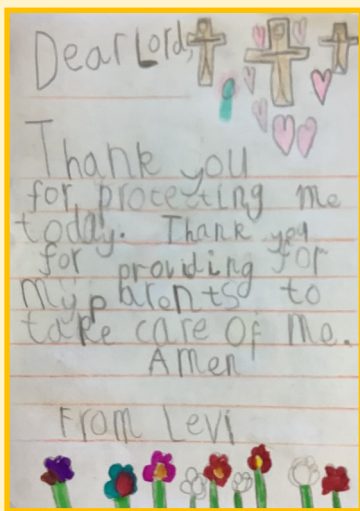
